HOW MUCH DOES
A GARDEN COST?

LARGE GARDENS 1000 - 2500m²

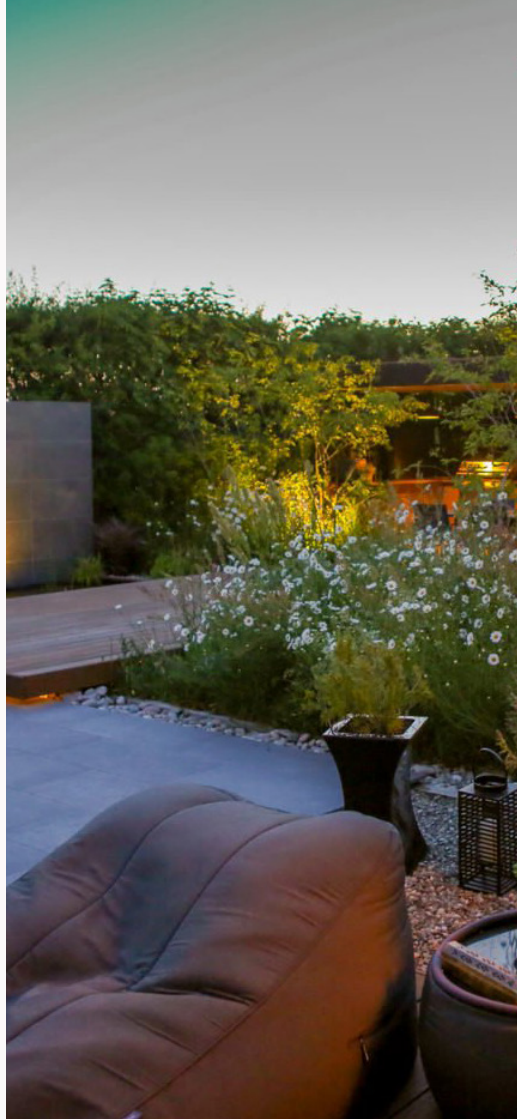
The example projects shown here cost between £145,000 and £250,000 *including VAT*.

MEDIUM GARDENS 500 - 1000m²

Medium gardens of this standard, including this level of detail would cost on average £100,000 - £200,000 .



SMALL GARDENS 250 - 500m²

EXTRA SMALL GARDENS 100 - 250m²

Gardens of this size, standard, and level of detail would cost on average £30,000 - £75,000 including VAT.
